Research

As a research organisation, IDU conducts cutting-edge research in the field of theatre studies and cultural policy, funded from various resources. We have repeatedly succeeded in obtaining support from national and international grants (Erasmus+, GA ČR, TA ČR, Creative Europe). ATI also receives support for the long-term conceptual development of a research organisation (IP DKRVO). Within this framework, it applied 13 research results in 2022, with a further 9 results applied outside the funding framework of IP DKRVO.

Overview of activities

COMMUNICATION AND MARKETING DEPARTMENT (OKAM)

The department provides communication campaigns, press services, social media management and external and internal communication. In 2022, the number of followers of the Institute of Arts - Theatre Institute FB page increased to 3700 and the IG profile @jsme_idu increased to 1293 followers. In 2022, ATI continued to produce its own podcast series Suflér.

ARTS INSTITUTE (AI)

The AI is a promotion, information, education, consultancy and research centre dedicated primarily to contemporary art. AI implements activities, projects and programmes reflecting current needs and thus contributing to their development. The project-based way of working includes:

International presentations and collaborations, residencies

Due to the current situation in Ukraine, three of the planned international residencies took place in 2022 and the remaining funds were used to support Ukrainian artists in the Czech Republic. 2 residencies of Czech artists took place at the Delfina Foundation in London and 1 at the Czech Centre Bucharest. 9 Ukrainian artists were supported in the Czech Republic in cooperation with Artivist Lab. 8 residencies took place at the Egon Schiele Art Centre in Český Krumlov. The ATI was a partner of the 11th edition of the Visegrad Literary Residency Programme (VLRP). 6 organisations were supported in the framework of the programme to support events presenting contemporary Czech visual arts abroad.

Information service and platforms

Culturenet.cz is an online platform for professionals across disciplines; it informs about current events (job offers, grant calls, new publications, etc.) and maintains databases of cultural subjects, grant providers and cultural policy literature. Number of page views in 2022: 575 840, 48 newsletters sent out with a total of approx. 5 200 updates (30% increase compared to 2021).

Kreativní Česko / zakreativnicesko.cz is a platform aimed at raising awareness of the importance of the creative industries through articles, interviews, reports and podcasts on the promotion of cultural and creative industries.

ArtsCzech.cz publishes calls in and news about Czech culture in English, including a regular newsletter.

CzechMobility.Info supports international and domestic artistic cooperation. Through an online portal, consultations (8 in 2022) and workshops (3), it provides assistance to cultural professionals with practical mobility issues (taxes, visas, insurance and copyright agreements).

PerformCzech is an information portal promoting Czech performing arts abroad. In 2022, the catalogue of productions was continuously updated and information about contemporary Czech theatre, new circus and dance was published.

SoundCzech updated and clarified its database of contacts and expanded it to include the classical music section of soundczech.cz. It continuously publishes an overview of new support opportunities for the music sector.

Professional growth

The 7th year of the ATI Academy training program was held in 2022. 18 representatives from 9 cultural organisations, selected through an open call, participated in the management programme aimed at developing a strategic plan. In addition, the Academy organised 7 training events for the professional public - 171 participants. A call for participation in the management programme for 2023 was launched.

Research

The activities were carried out in accordance with the research concept for the cultural policy area for the period 2019-2023 within the task: mapping the status, structure, conditions,

funding and needs of the arts and the social status of artists in the Czech Republic. In 2022, the following publications were published as part of the research: Český tanec v datech 8/ Publikum baletu a nového cirkusu, Český tanec v datech 9/ Taneční kariéry – kontexty a příklady a článek Uplatnitelnost na trhu práce v oblasti klasické hudby. Koresponduje vzdělávání v ČR v oboru s pracovním trhem? Musicologica Brunensia 1/2022. The text of the e-publication Artists' Labour Market Applicability - Classical Music in the EU Context by Lenka Dohnalová and Lucie Pešl Šilerová was completed. The IU experts provided consultations and participated in events with their expertise: e.g. evaluation of the calls of the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic, preparation of implementation and evaluation of the calls of the National Renewal Plan in the chapter Status of the Artist, implementation of calls under the EEA and Norway Grants and the podcast series Suflér and Kreative Česko.

SoundCzech (SC)

SoundCzech - export music office supported 85 music professionals in their support programmes: **Links OUT** - travel and networking and the presentation of 24 music artists/bands at international music showcase festivals/conferences. **Connect** - 6 exchange concerts with a foreign partner. **Connect Create** - 9 new music projects in collaboration with international music artists. **On Road** - 22 international concert performances/tours. **International PR** - 6 international media campaigns. **Skills** - 8 educational projects.

Czech Music Council (CMC)

CMC has participated in regular discussions on creative education for children at national and international level. In cooperation with the European Music Council, it collaborated on the *Working conditions of artists and cultural professionals* questionnaire. In addition to other expert activities, it organised the international interdisciplinary conference *Complex Impact of Music on Pedagogical Processes*.

DIVISION OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION (DIC/OKAM)

The activities of DIC (under the PerformCzech name) include the programmes Promotion of Czech Performing Arts Abroad and Presentation of the Czech Republic at International Fairs and Festivals. The DIC administers the Go and See programme, covers the agenda of Czech centres of the international NGOs (AICT, ASSITEJ, ITI, OISTAT, UNIMA) and coordination or membership in IETM and PACE.V4. The DIC arranged a presentation at the Tanzmesse and CINARS fairs and a theatre programme in Belgium as part of the Czech presidency of the Council of the European Union. 30 foreign experts participated in 2 editions of the HI PerformanCZ Visitors' Program. Thanks to the increase in the budgets of the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic- Czech Recovery Plan - Status of the Artist, Mobility I, many trips abroad and events aimed at international cooperation were supported. The PerformCzech LINKS OUT and Performing Arts Residencies and Study Visits programme supported over 100 people, the Go and See programme supported 97 people and the programme for organisers of professional events supported 17 projects. DIC coordinated the 10th annual Theatre Night. It continued to implement projects supported by Creative Europe and Erasmus+ Create to Connect -> Create to Impact and Digital Leap. As part of ATI's institutional research, DIC published a printed version of the publication Theatre and Freedom – The First Decade of Independence of Czech Theatre after 1989.

THE THEATRE INSTITUTE (TI)

In 2022, projects in the field of theatre history research continued. The main output is the online Czech Theatre Encyclopedia. The digitisation of the documentary collection was ongoing: 54,051 productions, 6,306 events and festivals, 477,430 photographs (an increase of 44,733) and 55,474 scenic and costume designs (an increase of 1,322) were processed. *The Oral History of Czech Theatre* project is being continuously implemented - 120 interviews were filmed last year. The TI database is being linked to the Wikidata platform - these activities have been extended to the international field, where the TI is coordinating a pilot project with 6 organisations under the ENICPA international network. The 3rd call for the Czech Theatre Photography Competition was announced.

Information and Documentation Department

The internal database *Theatre* was expanded in the Productions segment by 764 premieres and 377 records of older productions. In the Events/Festivals/Hosting segment, an additional 166 festivals, 74 trips abroad, 59 receptions of foreign companies, 17 exhibitions and 69 events such as lectures, awards, conferences, etc. were entered. 900 theatre events were newly digitised. 769 productions and programmes were added to the video library. Materials on 290 personalities were scanned from the personnel fund. Within the *Oral History of Czech Theatre* project, 14 new recordings were created.

Library

The ATI Library has a unique collection of Czech and foreign specialist theatre literature, dramatic texts, literature of related disciplines including specialist and cultural periodicals. With approx. 126,000 volumes, it is one of the largest libraries of its kind in Europe. Presentation of the digitised documents online is carried out in the Kramerius system and in the Portaro Digital Library Catalogue. Number of registered readers: 8 564. Number of additions to the library's collection in 2022: 2 555. The ATI Library is a member of SIBMAS (The International Association of Libraries, Museums, Archives and Documentation Centres of the Performing Arts), coordinating the activities of 27 members and acting as the secretariat of the national SIBMAS organisation.

Bibliography Department

The department creates an electronic database of article bibliography, which by the end of 2022 will contain 377,000 records on Czech and world theatre from Czech and foreign periodicals. Approximately 150 titles of Czech print and electronic newspapers and magazines and approximately 100 titles of foreign periodicals have been excerpted. The department cooperates with the National Library of the Czech Republic - it creates Name Authorities and contributes to the ANL catalogue.

Department of Collections and Archives (OSA)

The main task is to acquire, preserve and present collections and archival artefacts and documents relating to theatre, especially in the Czech Republic. In 2022, OSA digitised and added over 37,000 records of theatre photographs and over 1,000 artifacts of stage design to the *Virtual Study Room*. The Advisory Board for Collection Development approved the acquisition of the scenographic works of Ludmila Pavlouskova and Michal Hess.

Czech Theatre Studies Department (KČD)

The lexicographic project Czech Theatre Encyclopaedia is the department's long-term task. In 2022, an additional 25 entries were published on the CDE website in the sections German Drama, Czech Drama 1900-1945 and Czech Drama 1945-1989. In addition to participation in conferences and publications, the CCD is also involved in two grant projects of the Czech Science Foundation: *Podvod Allamody* (extended by 6 months) and the new project *Spaßmacher: Laik a/nebo profesionál? Divadlo v prostředí české šlechty ve druhé polovině 17. století.* In cooperation with the ATI Library, the department organised the Adolf Scherl Archive and Library. The department organises regular lectures of the Theatrical Society and the Summer Theatrical Symposium.

Editorial Department

The Editorial Department publishes original and translated works in the field of theatre history, theory and criticism in the editions České divadlo (which also includes the series Eseje, kritiky, analýzy) and Světové divadlo, but also outside this field. He also publishes an edition of dramatic texts called Divadelní hry.

PRAGUE QUADRENNIAL OF PERFORMANCE DESIGN AND SPACE (PQ)

During the year, preparations for the 15th edition of PQ, which will take place 8-18 June 2023, were underway. Open calls for all the PQ projects were closed and evaluated, and production requests from curators of countries and regions were continuously addressed, with a large number of the curators from the participating countries and regions visited the WHERE ARE WE Symposium on 4-6 May 2022 to see the main locations for the exhibitions. In the field of international cooperation, the Erasmus+ supported project Canon of Technical Theatre History was completed. PQ received a new grant from Creative Europe to support the Active CITY(zens) project on audience development. It will run from 2023-24.

CREATIVE EUROPE CULTURE OFFICE

The year 2022, the first year of the new Creative Europe programme's financial framework, was dedicated to both a summary of the previous seven-year financial period and the introduction of the new programme with a set of webinars. These were followed by a consultation and a course for applicants. As a result of the pandemic, some activities had to be moved online or cancelled. Continuous work continued on the new website. At the beginning of the year, KKEK was involved in the #zakreativnicesko campaign. Cooperation with candidate cities preparing their application for the title of ECoC 2028 continued. Organising events - Centre of interest: COVID as an opportunity and Centre of Interest: Women's Power and Culture.
